Parent Testimony – Gavin (3 years old)

In February of 2016, the Lions Club came to our Elementary School to perform a routine eye screening for all students, including my 3-year-old son, Gavin. In this screening, the test found a problem in Gavin's left eye. Following up on this screening, I took Gavin to a pediatric ophthalmologist in Glastonbury revealing serious problems with his eye immediately resulting in glasses. Gavin has far sightedness, slight astigmatism and his left eye wanders and he may need a patch in the near future. Without this screening, we would have discovered these problems much later, causing further damage to his eye and the nerve connection to his brain. The ophthalmologist also said, had we waited, Gavin could have possibly been legally blind in his left eye. We were completely shocked and scared.

We are incredibly grateful to the Lions Club for providing this service, which has truly changed our lives. Our son's vision is in the process of being repaired and decreasing the progressive damage he would have had I not brought him to the ophthalmologist at such a young age. Saving Gavin's eyesight was a direct result of a simple screening. We feel truly blessed.
